

ABSTRAK

Virus corona selain berdampak terhadap ekonomi juga berdampak di bidang pendidikan. Agar tidak disalahartikan sebagai hari libur, maka proses kegiatan pembelajaran dilakukan secara online. Pembelajaran daring pada anak sekolah dasar memerlukan peran aktif orang tua, karena pada anak sekolah dasar masih sangat memerlukan pendampingan orang tua. Tujuan penelitian mengetahui hubungan pengetahuan ibu tentang covid-19 dengan sikap ibu dalam pembelajaran daring pada anak sekolah dasar di Desa Campurdarat Kecamatan Campurdarat Kabupaten Tulungagung tahun 2021. Penelitian dilakukan tanggal 24 Mei sampai dengan 1 Juni 2021. Desain penelitian analitik korelasional dengan pendekatan cross sectional. Populasi penelitian seluruh ibu yang mempunyai anak sekolah dasar di Desa Campurdarat Kecamatan Campurdarat Kabupaten Tulungagung sejumlah 824 ibu, sampel diambil dengan teknik simple random sampling sejumlah 90 orang. Variabel pengetahuan ibu tentang covid-19, variabel terikat sikap ibu dalam pembelajaran daring pada anak. Data diolah dengan editing, coding, scoring dan tabulating, kemudian dianalisis menggunakan uji Spearman Rho dengan program SPSS. Hasil penelitian didapatkan sebagian besar responden mempunyai pengetahuan tentang covid-19 dalam kategori baik yaitu sebanyak 61 responden (67,78%) dan sebagian besar responden mempunyai sikap positif yaitu sebanyak 62 responden (68,89%). Ada hubungan pengetahuan ibu tentang covid-19 dengan sikap ibu dalam pembelajaran daring pada anak sekolah dasar di Desa Campurdarat Kecamatan Campurdarat Kabupaten Tulungagung tahun 2021 dimana hasil uji statistic Spearman Rho didapatkan p value = 0,000 dan α = 0,05 dimana p value < α . Ibu yang memiliki pengetahuan yang baik tentang covid-19 akan memiliki sikap positif tentang pembelajaran daring guna mencegah penularan covid-19. Semakin baik pengetahuan ibu tentang covid-19 maka akan semakin positif sikap ibu dalam pembelajaran daring pada anak sekolah dasar.

ABSTRACT

The corona virus not only has an impact on the economy but also has an impact on education. In order not to be misinterpreted as a holiday, the learning process is carried out online. Bold learning in elementary school children requires the active role of parents, because elementary school children still really need parental assistance. The purpose of the study was to determine the relationship between mother's knowledge about covid-19 and mother's attitude in daring learning to elementary school children in Campurdarat Village, Campurdarat District, Tulungagung Regency in 2021. The study was conducted from May 24 to June 1, 2021. The research design was analytic corelational with cross sectional approach. The research population of all mothers who have primary schools in Campurdarat Village, Campurdarat District, Tulungagung Regency, amounted to 824 mothers, the sample was taken by simple random sampling technique of 90 people. Mother's knowledge variable about covid-19, mother's attitude variable in daring learning to children. The data was processed by editing, coding, scoring and tabulating, then analyzed using the Spearman Rho test with the SPSS program. The results of the study obtained that most of the respondents had knowledge about covid-19 in the good category, namely 61 respondents (67.78%) and most of the respondents had a positive attitude, namely 62 respondents (68.89%). There is a relationship between knowledge about covid-19 and mother's attitude in bold learning to elementary school children in Campurdarat Village, Campurdarat District, Tulungagung Regency in 2021 where the results of the Spearman Rho statistical test obtained p value = 0.000 and $\alpha = 0.05$ where p value < α . Mothers who have good knowledge about covid-19 will have a positive attitude about learning to be brave to prevent the transmission of covid-19. The better the mother's knowledge about COVID-19, the more positive the mother's attitude in bold learning in elementary school children will be.
